The Crocker Mansion in Mahwah, New Jersey

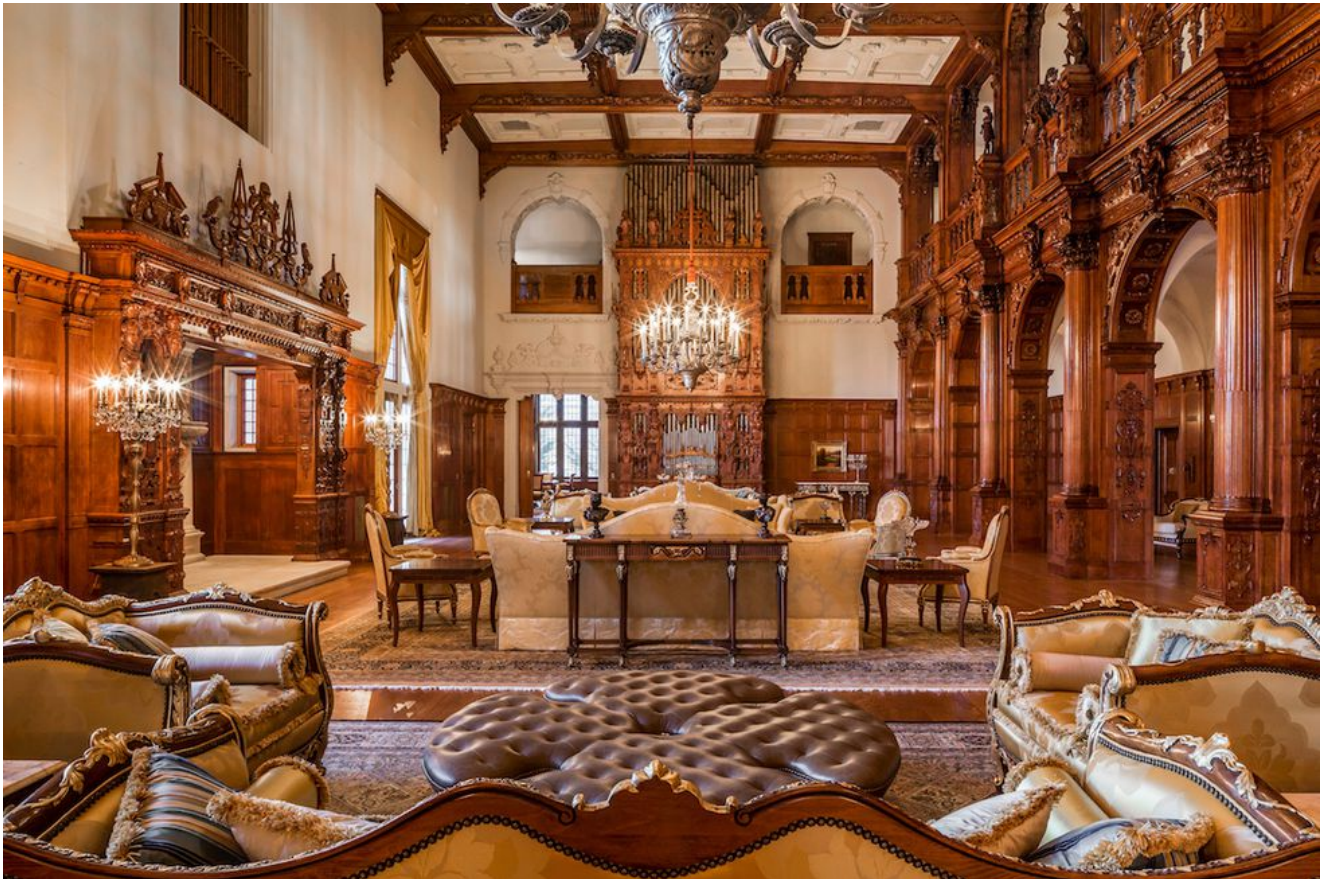
